2. COMPOSITION

Thyme (Linalol Type) (*Thymus Zygis*), Bergamot (Standard) (*Citrus Bergamia*), Lavender French (*Lavandula Angustifolia*) & Eucalyptus (Citriodora) (*Eucalyptus Citriodora*).

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Concentrated oils which are hazardous if ingested. Use sparingly on skin in dilution only.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE CONTACT – Rinse eyes immediately with lots of water. Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.

SKIN CONTACT - Remove all contaminated clothing and soak skin thoroughly with soap and water.
Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.

INGESTION - Wash mouth out completely with water. Seek immediate medical advice.

INHALATION - Remove to fresh air and rest.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Keep away from all sources of ignition. Use CO₂, Foam or Dry powder extinguishers only. DO NOT use direct water on burning oils. Avoid inhaling vapours and fumes and use breathing apparatus and protective clothing. Any closed containers may build up pressure at elevated temperatures. If possible cool off containers with cool water spray.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS

Use protective equipment (waterproof boots, safety glasses and protective clothing).

ENVIRONMENT PRECAUTIONS

Keep away from drains, surface and groundwater, and soil.

METHODS FOR CLEANING UP

Contain spilled material. Cover with an inert or non-combustible inorganic absorbent material, or sweep up and remove to an approved disposal container. Avoid naked flames or other sources of ignition.

7. HANDLING & STORAGE

PRECAUTIONS IN HANDLING

Apply good manufacturing practice and industrial hygiene practices, with proper ventilation. Do not eat drink or smoke while handling. Observe good personal hygiene.

STORAGE CONDITIONS

Ideally store in cool dry and ventilated area (preferably around 15C if possible) and away from heat sources. Protect from light in tightly closed original container. Keep air contact to a minimum.

FIRE PROTECTION

Keep away from naked flames and heat sources.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION

VENTILATION Ensure good ventilation of working area.

HAND PROTECTION Avoid prolonged contact with skin in undiluted form. Wear protective gloves.

WORK PRACTICES Wash hands with soapy water after handling.

REACTIVITY

It presents no significant reactivity hazards, by itself or in contact with water. Avoid contact with strong acids, alkali or oxidising agents.

DECOMPOSITION

Carbon monoxide and other organic compounds may be formed during combustion of oils.
