#### 2. COMPOSITION

Melissa Essential Oil, Jojoba Oil (Golden)

#### 3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Hazardous if ingested. Jojoba oil with a 2% dilution of essential oil.

#### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

EYE CONTACT - Rinse eyes immediately with lots of water or eyewash solution. Seek medical advice if symptoms persist.

SKIN CONTACT - Remove all contaminated clothing and wash with soap and water.

INGESTION - Wash mouth out completely with water. Seek immediate medical advice. If swallowed do not induce vomiting and seek medical advice.

INHALATION - Move to fresh air and rest.

#### 5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Keep away from all sources of ignition. Use CO<sub>2</sub>, Foam or Dry powder extinguishers only. DO NOT use direct water on burning oils. Avoid inhaling vapours and fumes and use protective clothing. On extreme long heat at high temperature gaseous components occur of acrolein variety. Any closed containers may build up pressure at elevated temperatures. If possible cool off containers with cool water spray.

#### 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

##### PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS

Wear suitable gloves for disposal of waste.

##### ENVIRONMENT PRECAUTIONS

Contain the leak with earth or sand and keep away from drains, surface and groundwater, and soil.

##### METHODS FOR CLEANING UP

Contain spilled material. Cover with an inert or non-combustible inorganic absorbent material, or sweep up and remove to an approved disposal container. Avoid naked flames or other sources of ignition.

## 7. HANDLING & STORAGE

### PRECAUTIONS IN HANDLING

Apply good manufacturing practice and industrial hygiene practices, with proper ventilation. Do not eat drink or smoke while handling. Observe good personal hygiene. Avoid contact with eyes.

### STORAGE CONDITIONS

Ideally store in cool dry and ventilated area and away from heat sources. Protect from light in tightly closed original container. Keep air contact to a minimum. Store away from oxidizing materials such as bleach.

### FIRE PROTECTION

Keep away from naked flames and heat sources.

## 8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION

VENTILATION            Ensure good ventilation of working area.

HAND PROTECTION    Wear protective gloves.

WORK PRACTICES     Wash hands with soapy water after handling.

ODOUR                Mellow odour with a faint smoky note

APPEARANCE    Pale Yellow mobile liquid

FLASH POINT (Degrees Celsius) 54C

SOLUBILITY    Not soluble in water but is soluble in an alcohol blend

## 10. STABILITY & REACTIVITY

### REACTIVITY

It presents no significant reactivity hazards, by itself or in contact with water. Avoid contact with strong acids, alkali or oxidising agents.

### DECOMPOSITION

Carbon monoxide and other organic compounds may be formed during combustion of oil.

## 11. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Materials are safe when used as directed. Jojoba Oil non toxic – food grade.

## 12. ECOLOGICAL INFORMATION

BIODEGRADABILITY    Jojoba Oil readily biodegradable. Melissa Oil is degradable but should not be released into the environment.

PRECAUTIONS            Prevent surface contamination of soil, ground and surface water.
